 (Sampradayam) of Dhruva Jnanam that none should utter 'OM' karam or any bijaksharams in classes and presentations.

CLASSROOM GUIDELINES

- It will be helpful for students if they come prepared to the class with the material provide on website.
- Slokas from 'Valmiki Ramayana' will not be taught in class. Slokas were given in the document for reference only.



- * No sloka chanting will happen during class. Children will learn from the videos provided which helps to maintain consistency in chanting. This will also help in the future for group programs. Request all parents to play them repeatedly during the week.
- Please note that the intention of the course is to thoroughly understand the concepts of Sanatana Dharma rather than memorize. 8

- Please make sure that students turn their cameras on and unmute themselves during the class.



PROGRESS REPORTS / CERTIFICATES



- Level 1 6 : At the end of each academic year, average of all the three trimesters is taken.
- Certificate will be awarded based on the following criteria.
- Successful completion 50% or above
- Distinction- 80% or above
- Foundation Level: Student's attendance is considered for giving certificate. Certificate will be given based on teacher's approval.



- Taking test in every trimester is mandatory to move to the next level. This cannot be exempted. Encourage students to take tests on time.
- For the convenience of all the students to take test at their own schedule, a 4-week time will be given to complete and submit the test.
- There is a late penalty of 1 mark for each calendar day in the delay of submission of the test within the grace period of 2 weeks.
- * The test will no longer be available on the website after 6 weeks.

TRIMESTER END EVENTS

- At the end of every Trimester, Elocution and Kahoot games will be conducted.
- Registration is required to participate in these events.
- Event registrations are open 4 weeks prior to the date of event.
- Please register before the last date.


